

## 2 – Boiling Hot

Romans 12:11 (NIV)

*“Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervour, serving the Lord.”*

As I spend time in the secret place, I sometimes ask the Holy Spirit to guide my movements, using my whole body to express what I sense is in His heart.

This time, I found myself stirring the air in front of me—big, circular motions, like I was stirring a giant pot. Suddenly, the pot began to bubble, then boil furiously.

## Reflect & Respond

- Holy Spirit, what area of my life do You long to reignite?  
Where are You desiring to bubble up and boil over in me?
- Father God, is there any fear in me of letting the Holy Spirit take over—fear of what might happen if I fully surrender? Am I worried about losing control or about how I might appear if you move in unusual ways?

## Activation

This week, choose to do something with great passion. Let your response to God erupt! Worship like never before. Pray with eager expectation. Leap for joy in gratitude. Ask the Lord to fill you to overflowing in every part of your life.

If you find it hard to express yourself this way—if there's hesitation, fear, or even resistance—ask someone to pray with you. Invite the Holy Spirit to stir up boldness and freedom within you.
